



## Patriot Jeremiah Burnett III Jackson County, Missouri 1749-1848

Jeremiah Burnett III assisted in establishing American Independence as a Private, Capt James Franklin's Company of Foot, 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment; enlisting 26 Dec 1777. He also provided food for a hospital at the Henry County Courthouse, Virginia. Jeremiah's service is documented at the U.S. National Archives & Records Administration.

Jeremiah (son of Jeremiah Burnett II and Elizabeth Claybrook) was born 1749, Virginia; died 28 Jun 1848, Jackson County, Missouri; and buried Blue Springs Cemetery, Blue Springs, Jackson County, Missouri. Jeremiah married Nancy Crowley. Nancy was born 1753. Children:

- Obadiah (1764-1839).

Jeremiah married Mary Johnston, 14 Sep 1781, Montgomery County, Virginia. Mary was born 1762 and died 1798. Children:

- John Burnett (1784-1828).
- Jeremiah Burnett IV (1792-1875).
- Samuel Burnett (1793-1860). Samuel married Laveniah Leah Cox.
- Elizabeth Burnett (1798-1860). Elizabeth married Dabney Johnson.

Jeremiah married Effaniah Crowley, 29 Oct 1801, Henry County, Virginia. Effaniah was born 1761 and died 1848. Children:

- Rhoda Effaniah Burnett (1800-1870). Rhoda married William Barris
- Judah Burnett (1802-1870).
- Wilson Cornelius Burnett (1805-1863).
- Nancy Burnett (1808-1883).



The Blue Springs Cemetery is located at 2800 Southwest Walnut Street, Blue Springs, Missouri. The cemetery is open to the public. Jeremiah's gravesite is in the northwest section at coordinates: N39° 01' 00" and W94° 17' 43".
