



Patriot Joseph Hall Cass County, Missouri 1764-1843

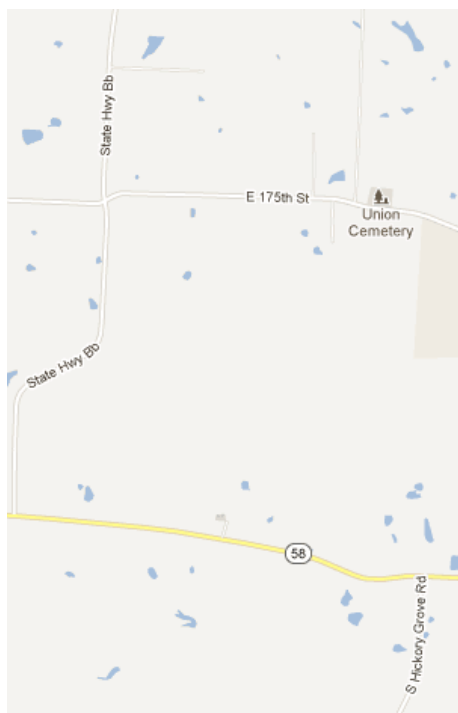
Joseph Hall assisted in establishing American Independence as a Private, Capt Snood, Woods, and Whitley's Company, Col Logan's Regiment, Virginia Militia. His service is documented in his pension application S13302 at the U.S. National Archives & Records Administration.

Joseph (son of Andrew Hall and Mary Lapsley) was born 16 February 1764, Rockbridge County, Virginia; died 12 December 1843, Cass County, Missouri; and buried Union Baptist Cemetery, Pleasant Hill, Cass County, Missouri. Joseph married Ann Barnett 2 January 1785, Lincoln County, Kentucky. Ann (daughter of John Barnett) was born 20 May 1763, Lincoln County, Kentucky and died 14 May 1844, Cass County, Missouri. Union Baptist Cemetery is located at 24740-25064 East 175th Street, Pleasant Hill, Cass County, Missouri. James has a military tombstone with a DAR marker located in the center of the cemetery at coordinates: N38° 47' 59.03" and W94° 18' 07.81".
