

Patriot Isaac Drake Jackson County, Missouri 1764-1837

Isaac Drake assisted in establishing American Independence as a Private, Capt Hendrix' Company, 1st Essex County Regiment, New Jersey Militia. Isaac's service is documented with the New Jersey state archives collection.

Isaac (son of Jacob and Helen Drake) was born Feb 1764, Morristown, Morris County, New Jersey; died 27 Jan 1837, Jackson County, Missouri; and buried Drake Family Cemetery, Jackson County, Missouri. Isaac married Frances Monroe, 16 Sep 1797, Campbell County, Kentucky. Frances was born 10 Mar 1775; died 5 Sep 1849; and buried Drake Family Cemetery, Jackson County, Missouri. Children:


- William Drake (1806-). William married Sarah Graham.

- Isaac Drake, Jr. (1810-1907).
- Andrew Jackson Drake (1812-1887). Andrew married Elizabeth Mitchell.

The Drake Family Cemetery is located on private property at 3425 North Perrin Road, Independence, Jackson County, Missouri. Isaac's gravesite is at coordinates: N39° 09' 52" and W94° 16' 57".
