



## Patriot Anthony Thomas Lafayette County, Missouri 1759-1825

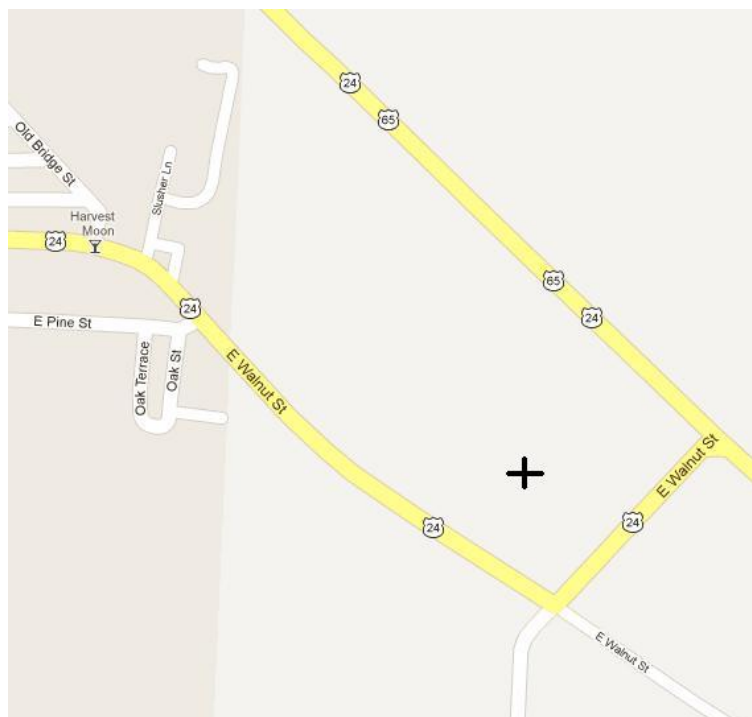
Patriot Anthony Thomas assisted in establishing American Independence as a Private, Maryland Militia. He enrolled in a Maryland Flying Camp Company, enrolled by Captain Jacob Good and accepted by Coronel Charles Beatty on 20 July 1776.

Anthony Thomas (son of Notley Thomas and Rebecka Griffith) was born 4 July 1759 in Frederick County, Maryland, died 17 April 1825 in Waverly, Lafayette County, Missouri; and buried at Thomas-Buck-Galbraith Cemetery, Waverly, Lafayette County, Missouri.

Anthony married Lucy Cecil on 30 January 1782 in Prince George County, Maryland. Lucy (daughter of John Cecil and Wilson Brightwell) was born 18 April 1763 in Prince George, Maryland, died 27 March 1832 in Waverly, Lafayette County, Missouri, and buried adjacent to Anthony at Thomas-Buck-Galbraith-Cemetery, Waverly, Lafayette County, Missouri 1832. Children:

- John Dennis Thomas (1783-1866)
- Notley Thomas (1784-1839). Notley married Lucy Smith.
- Rebecca Thomas (1791-1877). Rebecca Married Perry Green Buck
- Susana Thomas (1798- ).
- Elizabeth Thomas (1800-1866). Elizabeth married Galbraith.
- Samuel Thomas (1802- ).

Thomas-Buck-Galbraith Cemetery is located one-quarter mile east of Waverly bordered by US-65 and US-24 highways in Lafayette County, Missouri at coordinates: N39° 12' 17.54" and W93° 30' 25.46". The DAR Anthony Thomas Chapter was named for this patriot.
